

Word building	Phonemic awareness with letters (blending/segmenting) Building words with target phonics	Introduce new sounds: b, c, g, h Word building	5 mins
Word reading	Decoding words (read single words with new sounds/letters)	bat got cab cap him hog	4 mins

Comprehension	Questions: Factual, Inferential, Prediction, Opinion, Summarizing text	What is the ant's name? What is he trying to do? What do you think will happen next? What is your favorite sport? Tell me what happens in the story.	3 mins
Dictation	Dictating a sentence from decodable book (this can be used as a quick assessment)	"Pip has a big pan. Pip can hit it."	3 mins





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
